Thus, we have implemented various actions to reduce the impact of our activity on nature while guaranteeing the well-being of our customers and staff. This charter presents our commitments and how you can participate in these efforts.

## $\sim~$ Our environmental commitments

#### 1. Energy:

- Trips within the campsite are mainly done with the help of electric carts.
- Replacement of the majority of light bulbs with economical models (energy class A or A+).
- Installation of motion detectors to limit unnecessary lighting.
- o Urban lighting has been replaced by LED lighting.

#### 2. Water:

- Rainwater recovery for watering the plantations and supplying the toilets of the toilets.
- Taps equipped with pushers to reduce water consumption.

## 3. Rubbish:

- Selective sorting organized with specific points for glass, plastic and paper.
- Composter available near the garden for organic waste.
- Limitation of packaging and reduction of waste produced.
- Recycling of hazardous waste (batteries, light bulbs) at the reception.

#### 4. Maintenance:

- Use of ecological, labelled or gentle chemical-based cleaning products.
- Preference for steam cleaning devices and modern materials to minimize the use of chemicals.
- The maintenance of the green spaces is carried out without pesticides with environmentally friendly products.

## 5. Biodiversity:

• Planting of local plant species to preserve the local ecosystem.

• Watering is reasoned, carried out early in the morning, and the lawns are not watered.

## 6. General ecological management:

- Documents are digitized as much as possible to reduce the use of paper (e.g., emailing contracts, brochures, etc.).
- Water and electricity meters are read every month to analyze and improve resource management.
- The sheets used are exclusively washable.

## 7. Eco-friendly transportation:

- The staff mainly travels by scooter or electric cart to limit the carbon footprint.
- Information available at the reception on walking routes, cycling routes and bus schedules.

#### 1. Energy:

- Turn off the lights when you leave a room or your rental.
- $_{\odot}$  Close doors and windows when the heating or cooling is on.

- Report any water leaks to staff.
- Don't let water run unnecessarily or flush things down the toilet.

#### 3. Rubbish:

- Sort your waste using the dedicated bins (yellow lid for recycling).
- Do not throw cigarette butts, papers or rubbish on the ground.
- Drop off hazardous waste at the reception desk and use the green bins for other waste.

#### 4. Transport :

- Prefer non-polluting modes of transport (cycling, walking).
- Do not leave your engine running when it is stationary.
